Guidelines:

2. Only a GSPIA faculty member can chair the committee.
3. The majority of the committee, including the major advisor, must be full or adjunct members of the graduate faculty. Go to <http://ir.pitt.edu/graduate-faculty-roster/> for the University of Pittsburgh faculty listings. Any change in the members of the committee must be approved by the other Committee members and the Doctoral Coordinator. When a change occurs in the membership of the Committee, the student is not eligible to defend the dissertation until 30 days has elapsed. A new Dissertation Committee Approval form will need completed and submitted to the Office of Student Services for posting.
4. All coordination between the dissertation Committee members is the student's responsibility.
